Accommodation may also be available before and after the event you are attending. The refectory offers delicious freshly-prepared meals.

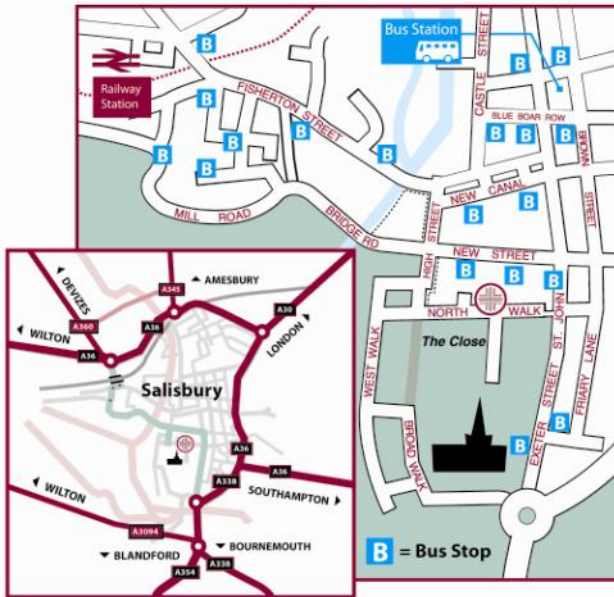
